## **POLICE UPDATE – BPD – SGT STEPHEN MOY**

There was 12 incidents last month. 9 out of the 12 incidents took place at bars around McKinley Square and involve drug activity. The BPD has ramped up patrols and there are 18 officers in plain clothes that have made 4 arrests. The other 3 incidents were Breaking & Entering at the Marriott, Battery March Street and India Row. The BPD is actively working to improve the homelessness situation in Christopher Columbus Park. They urge residents to call 911 to report any situation that requires attention as opposed to 311.

## **LONG WHARF SUBSURFACE UTILITY EASEMENT LEGISLATION – RICH MCGUINNESS, BPDA DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOR CLIMATE CHANGE & ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING**

Legislation has been filed that allows subsurface utility easements to the State Street portion of Long Wharf be given by the BPDA to utility companies servicing the Long Wharf area. The legislation is required for easements under open space protected by Article 96 of the Massachusetts Constitution. The owners of the Custom House Block building and Chart House ( Capital Properties) have been undergoing a major rehabilitation of their buildings

over the last few years and updates are required including an easement for Eversource in the Long Wharf Substation. The situation is extremely time sensitive as the building rehab is complete and ready to be occupied with new tenants.
